In the name of Allah, the Beneficent, the Merciful

Successful indeed are the believers. (1) Those who offer their Salât (prayers) with all solemnity and full submissiveness. (2) And those who turn away from Al-Laghw (dirty, false, evil vain talk, falsehood, and all that Allâh has forbidden). (3) And those who pay the Zakât. (4) And those who guard their chastity (i.e. private parts, from illegal sexual acts). (5) Except from their wives or (slaves) that their right hands possess, - for then, they are free from blame; (6) But whoever seeks beyond that, then those are the transgressors; (7) Those who are faithfully true to their Amanât (all the duties which Allâh has ordained, honesty, moral responsibility and trusts)[] and to their covenants; (8) And those who strictly guard their (five compulsory congregational) Salawât (prayers) (at their fixed stated hours).[] (9) These are indeed the inheritors. (10) Who shall inherit the Firdaus (Paradise). They shall dwell therein forever. (11) (Translation by Dr. Mohsin)

## Hadith (Memorization and Study):

(Riyadhus Saleheen# 1075)

وَعَنْ ابْنِ عُمَرَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُمَا، قَالَ: قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ، بُنِيَ الْإِسْلَامُ عَلَى خَمْسٍ:  
شَهَادَةِ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ، وَأَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ اللَّهِ، وَإِقَامِ الصَّلَاةِ، وَإِيتَاءِ الزَّكَاةِ، وَحَجِّ  
الْبَيْتِ وَصَوْمِ رَمَضَانَ -

Ibn `Umar (May Allah be pleased with them) reported: The Messenger of Allah (sallallaahu `alayhi wa sallam) said, "Islam is based on five (pillars): testifying that there is no true god except Allah and that Muhammad (sallallaahu `alayhi wa sallam) is His slave and Messenger; performing of Salat (Iqamat-as-Salat); the payment of Zakat; performing Hajj (pilgrimage) to the House [of Allah (Ka`bah)]; and Saum (fasting) during the month of Ramadan."  
[Al-Bukhari and Muslim].

**Commentary:** In this Hadith, Islam has been compared to a building which rests on five pillars. As a building cannot stand without its foundation, similarly, Islam cannot exist without these pillars. For this reason, he who denies any one of these obligations is a disbeliever, and he who neglects any of them due to slackness or want of attention is a sinful and impious Muslim.

## Dua (Memorization):

رَبِّ أَوْزِعْنِي أَنْ أَشْكُرَ نِعْمَتَكَ الَّتِي أَنْعَمْتَ عَلَيَّ وَعَلَى وَالِدَيَّ وَأَنْ أَعْمَلَ صَالِحًا تَرْضَاهُ  
وَأَصْلِحْ لِي فِي ذُرِّيَّتِي إِنِّي تُبْتُ إِلَيْكَ وَإِنِّي مِنَ الْمُسْلِمِينَ -

"My Lord! Grant me the power and ability that I may be grateful for Your Favour which You have bestowed upon me and upon my parents, and that I may do righteous good deeds, such as please You, and make my off-spring good. Truly, I

have turned to You in repentance, and truly, I am one of the Muslims (submitting to Your Will)."

**Instructions:**

1. Memorization should include both Arabic script as well as English translation.
2. Study should include in-depth understanding from other Ayats, Ahadith and other literature. ICNA-Chapter can help in this by having dedicated study circles on these lines.
3. Study should include all aspects; including knowledge, understanding and practice in real life.
4. We all should share these topics among our families as well.

**General Guidelines:**

1. Each one of us should plan to pray obligatory Salah with Jamah in the masjid. A good starting point is try to be regular in Isha and Fajr Salat with Jama' in the Masjid.
2. Each member should have his own private library.
3. Each one of us should plan to study at least few verses with Tafseer daily.
4. Each one of us should have one book in regular study.
